*we are sad that Jesus had to die on the cross.*

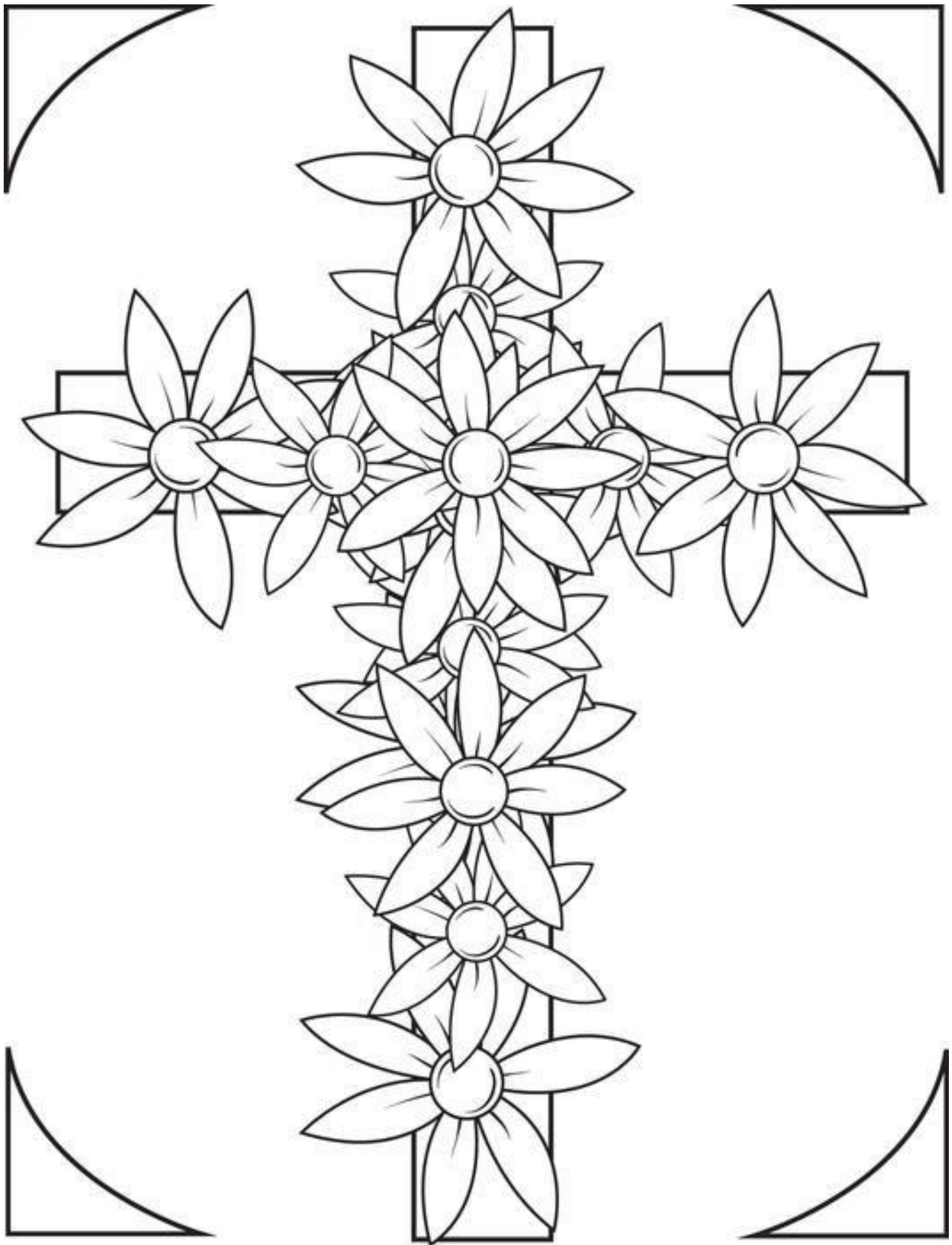
*We are sad that people still get hurt every day,*

Doubting Thomas

Although you have not seen him, you love him; and even though you do not see him now, you believe in him and rejoice with an indescribable and glorious joy. ~ 1 Peter 1:8 ~

**Read...** Jesus appears to disciples, [John 20:24-29](#)

**Talk...** what do we do when we doubt or struggle with our faith?

**Listen...** [Oceans \(Where feet may fail\)](#) by Hillsong

**Do...** play the [Doubting Game](#)

Prepare pieces of paper with various facts and lies on them. Take turns taking a slip of paper from a bag. Read the slip out loud and, say either, I DOUBT IT or I BELIEVE IT!

**Make...** [I Believe Hand Prints](#)

Trace your hand on a piece of light-coloured paper. Draw a HEART in the middle of your palms. Write one of each of these words on each finger of a hand (Thumb - "I"; pointer finger BELIEVE; middle finger JESUS, ring finger IS; pinky finger ALIVE"). Decorate your hands.

**Try...** A trust exercise

Fall backwards and let someone catch you. Alternatively, you can try the human knot, or be blind-folded someone and let someone else guide you around the room.

**Pray...**

*Dear God, take our doubts and show us you are real so our faith can grow. Thank you that Thomas who was able to see and believe you. Thank you also, that even though we cannot see you Jesus, you rose from the dead, and we know that you are alive. Amen.*
