Collective Worship


Mr Phillip Kaye lead our Collective worship on Monday. We all loved his assembly on the parable of the vineyard. The engagement was outstanding.

Although becoming a governor requires drive and commitment, you'll enjoy many professional and personal rewards, including career development opportunities and the chance to support young people's futures.
