Remember to ask permission first.

Draw (sketch) the fruits and vegetables that you have at home. Record how they look on the outside.

Draw (sketch) what they look like on the inside. Ask someone to cut them for you.

Try to match the different colours you see by blending pencil crayons together. (Blending = gently colouring two or more colours on top of each other to develop different shades,

e.g. both greens together with a hint of brown)

Experiment with different colouring tools.

e.g. wax crayons, felt tips, paint.

Which colouring tools are easiest to blend?

Other art activities to try.

Make sculptures of fruits and vegetables in baskets or boxes using empty boxes, containers.

Make a collage using different types & colours of paper. Make fruity cartoon characters.







Design & Technology - Houses & Homes of the future.

Design (draw) a house (home) or city of the future. Will this building (city) be on land (inside a dome, high up on a mountain, in a desert), on or under the sea (oceans), on moons (other planets), in space or the centre of the Earth (underground).

You can design as many different homes (cities) as you like.

Think about the different features (parts) each home (city) might need or have for people to live comfortably there. What new gadgets might have been invented to go into a house (city) of the future.

Explain parts of your house (city), gadgets you create and safety features.

Make your house (city) of the future out of boxes and other bits and pieces you find around the home. REMEMBER to ASK PERMISSION to use things before starting and ask
