**Shared Days**

Kirklees Shared Live Relaunch their day support service

Kirklees Shared Lives, a scheme run by Kirklees Council is pleased to announce the relaunch of their day support service – Shared Days and they are recruiting carers

Shared Days is a day support service giving adults with learning disabilities, physical disabilities, older people, people with mental health needs and those living with onset dementia the opportunity to spend time with a registered Shared Lives carer at their home as an alternative to day services.

Shared Lives carers support service users on a one to one basis or set up a “friendship group” in their home offering support for up to 3 service users for one session. A friendship group may include setting up social activities such as arts and crafts, board games, a walk to the local park or simply watching a movie and using the carers home as a base.

Carers are expected to offer a minimum of 1 four hour session a week - it could be during the day, evenings or at the weekend.

Our Shared Lives carers represent all walks of life from across Kirklees. Unlike carers offering short breaks and long term support carers offering Shared Days are not required to have a spare bedroom.

Many of our Shared Lives carers are in full time or part time employment, taking care of a young family and lots of them are in retirement – the beauty of the scheme is that it’s about someone joining in with your everyday life.

Carers offering day support are paid £8.50 per service user, per hour. You do not need any specific qualifications and once your application has been received the approval process only takes a few short weeks and the Shared Lives team are on hand to give you all of the training and support you need.
