## Mrs Seage – 100 skips in a day in March

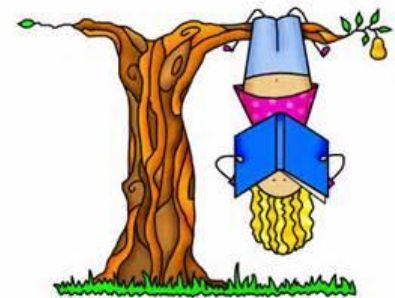
