Christmas Holidays

Public Health England has agreed a 6 day window after the final day of teaching in which school leaders are asked to remain contactable so they can assist with Covid tracing where necessary ie in our case up to Christmas Eve. After this date we should not need to contact parents to advise of the need for children to isolate in respect of a confirmed case in school during the previous week. After we break up any confirmed cases of Covid where symptoms start before 6pm on Sunday 20th Dec (no matter when the test result is received) MUST be notified by email to the school office as a matter of urgency. Confirmed cases where symptoms have started later than this, or isolation due to contact with someone testing positive, should still be advised by email so that we can monitor the situation and have an indication of any known absences prior to our return on Tuesday 5th January 2021.

Please remember that children should not be sent to school if they have Covid 19 symptoms, have tested positive within the last 10 days or if they are self-isolating due to a family member or a close contact having symptoms. Children showing symptoms of Covid 19 should undertake a test. If your child shows symptoms when in school we will ask you to collect them and arrange for them to have a test. Please advise us of the results of any tests promptly. We will comply with the requirements of the national track & trace programme which may mean that if anyone in school tests positive then adults/children who have had close contact with them will need to self-isolate for 10 days.

Please note that the self-isolation period has changed from 14 days to 10 days this week.
