Easter Holidays

Public Health England has agreed a 6 day window after the final day of teaching in which school leaders are asked to remain contactable so they can assist with Covid tracing where necessary ie in our case until tea time on Thursday 1st April. After this date we should not need to contact parents to advise of the need for children to isolate in respect of a confirmed case in school during the previous week. After we break up any confirmed cases of Covid where symptoms start before 6pm on Sunday 28th March (no matter when the test result is received) MUST be notified by email to the school office as a matter of urgency. Confirmed cases where symptoms have started later than this, or isolation due to contact with someone testing positive, should still be advised by email so that we can monitor the situation and have an indication of any known absences prior to our return on Monday 12th April 2021.

Year 5 Bikeability


Many of our Yr 5 children will be taking part in Bikeability training on 19th & 20th April. We are sure they will do well and hope they enjoy it.
