ENGLISH/PHONICS

As we return to school after lockdown we will be revisiting and recapping lots of the phonics. We will be completing simple assessments, checking understanding and finding out where your children are. We will consolidate their phonics and grammar rules with lots of games, writing small captions, revisiting the rules.

Children will also be reading as much as possible.

Please remember Spell Shed is updated weekly inline with what we are learning in class.

Science - Yr1/2

We will be doing all about growth and human timelines.

Reception chn learn about how we change through time too,

RSHE- we will giving children the opportunity to be outside more, build back relationships and confidence. Develop and rebuild friendships and support children where necessary

Reception chn will compare similarities and differences. Likes and dislikes between ourselves and others.

History-

We will continue to look at explorers not just from space. Including significant figures such as Amelia Earheart and Christopher cloumbus.

This half term we will continue to look Explorers

Weekly routines

Children will read with an adult on a Thursday.
If necessary a new book will be issued.

Maths Reception Maths

We will be looking at numbers to 20.

We will be thinking about adding one more, ordering and recognising numbers to 20.

Year one-

Children will use this half term to work on weight, mass, length and height. We will introduce standard units of measure and practice using rulers and centimetres to compare and measure.

Year Two-

Children will be working on developing their understanding of shape. Be able to use shape terminology to describe them and problem solve.

They will learn about fractions, such as 1/2 and 1/4.

Art/DT -

We will be doing large scale art, model making to support friendships and team work.

Music- We will begin to learn Easter songs.

Rec Chn will move to music in different ways.

ICT- Following instructions, direction, inputting information, simple programming and using beebots.

How can you help at home?

Children will soon be given a reading book and have access to spelling shed .

Encourage reading everyday.

This will benefit your child in all areas of learning. Reading with your child everyday can make a huge difference and is vital to their development to stay on track.
