Language & Literacy: This half term we will be learning about:

- Writing a past tense (historical) information report-Focusing on adverbials, pronoun use and tense.
- Using apostrophes for possession and contraction.
- The role of determiners.

We will be focussing heavily on presentation, spelling and handwriting this term. It is expected that all the children will join. The spellings for this half term are on the back of the curriculum outline.

Numeracy: This half term we will be learning about:

- Fractions (addition, subtraction, equivalence)
- Fraction and decimal equivalence (ordering and comparing)
- Multiplying a fraction by a whole number
- Fractions as division
- Decimal multiplication and estimation
- Percentages finding percentages of mutliples of 5
- Tackling word problems using all of the above
- Reading tables and line graphs

There will be big focus on the multiplication tables and developing both conceptual and procedural fluency with the chldren.

Science:

This half term we will be learning about:

Microbes - what they are and of what use are they?

Investigating the role of male and female pioneers in this field of Science.

Computing: This half term we will be learning about:

- · Coding.
- Research based work to enhance understanding in the foundation subjects.
- Using ICT to help develop understanding and skills in both literacy and Maths.
