We will be working on using suffix words in our writing, always including capital letters and full stops and using conjunctions to add more detail. To continue our addition and subtraction of two 2 digit numbers both in a number sentence and a word problem. Please can children continue to learn to tell the time to 5 minutes and practise reading scales at home, as these are a fantastic life skill and will also help with SATs preparation. Maths Target Yr 2: Must: Know their number bonds to 20 and able to use them to recall different number facts such as 60 + 40 = 100. Should: Know how to partition a two digit number into tens and ones. Could: Count in 3s from 0 to 36.			
Maths Target Yr 1: Must: Know their number bonds to 10 and able to use them to recall different number facts such as 10 + 90 = 100. Should: Recall common 2D and 3D shapes and discuss their features. Could: use arrays to multiply.
