Governor's	<b>Observations</b>	/Evaluation
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School was an extremely calm and purposeful place to visit. Every class that I visited I was greeted by polite and well-mannered children. In each class the children were attentive to their teacher and responded well to all their instructions well. The children were concentrating on their work and were engaged with the tasks they were doing. During my interview with the Investor in Pupil Council I found all the children to be very polite and courteous, to both myself and each other. I also felt that staff were always very positive and polite to all children and there seemed to be a good bond between children and adults.

## Culture observed in the school

It is very clear that the school is a very calm and considered place to be. There are lots of displays around school that celebrate the children's work and also emphasise the important values of being caring and kind to one another. This was through either distributing drinks, tidying away plates and cutlery or simply looking after each other and being caring to one another.
