Y3-6 Lent Club with Reverend Burge – Tuesdays at 12.30pm until 27th March

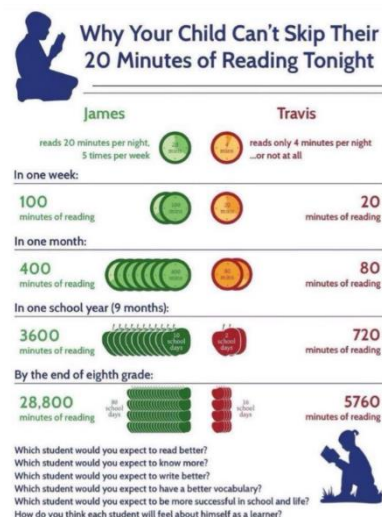
