Literacy:

Phonics: On-going according to Phase.

Speaking and Listening: Discussions around our class name and creating our class code and prayer. Comparing maps and discussing the changes to our local area over time.

Reading: Cultivating a love of reading by reading a variety of genres in groups and independently;

Writing: Reading stories from familiar settings: Only One You, Funnybones. Using our knowledge from focus books to write instructions, narratives and character/setting descriptions. **Forming our letters correctly will be a big focus this half term.**

Place Value: Identifying & representing numbers using objects & pictorial representations. Reading and writing numbers to 20 and beyond.

Using a part-whole model. Addition and subtraction calculations, recognising symbols (+ - < >)

Number bonds to 10.

Year 2

Literacy:

Phonics: Recapping Phase 5

Speaking and Listening: Discussions around our class name and creating our class code and prayer. Comparing maps and discussing the changes to our local area over time.

Reading: Cultivating a love of reading by reading a variety of genres in groups and independently;

Writing: Reading stories from familiar settings: Only One You, Funnybones. Using our knowledge from focus books to write instructions, narratives and character/setting descriptions. Using capital letters and full stops to form a short narrative. **Forming our letters correctly and working on neat, tidy presentation will be a big focus this half term.**

Maths:

Place Value: Identifying & representing numbers using objects & pictorial representations. Recognising the numbers in a 2-digit number.

Fact families bonds to 20. Addition and subtraction calculations 2-digit and 1 digit, recognising symbols (+ - < >)

How Can I Help?

*Ask questions about what they've done at school. ***Read with your child for at least 10 minutes every day and discuss it briefly afterwards.** *Offer help and encouragement with homework. *Help your child practise their spellings. *Ensure your child is using the correct pencil grip when writing and encourage correct letter formation.
