#### New Events...

#### KS2 (Y3-6) Prayer Space Workshops - Tuesday 2<sup>nd</sup> and Wednesday 3<sup>rd</sup> October

As part of our work as a church school and for our work in RE, the children in KS2 will be taking part in a Prayer Space Workshop, led by Yvonne Froud from Spen Valley Faith in Schools. The children will visit the Prayer Space in small groups for around 20 minutes. They will then create a reflective piece of work about how the visit made them feel.

#### **Scholastic Book Fair**

The Book Fair will be in school from **Friday 5<sup>th</sup> October until Thursday 11<sup>th</sup> October**. The books will be on display from **3.15pm until 3.45pm**. The children will also be able to visit the Book Fair during morning playtime from Monday 8<sup>th</sup> October and items will be available for them to buy. A reminder that our Harvest Appeal once again has a local focus and we are supporting the Salvation Army and Batley Food Bank. We will be collecting gifts of fresh fruit, vegetables and tinned goods. Please send these into school on the day of your child's visit to church. The children will be carrying their harvest gifts to display in the church on the day of their visit.

We are inviting you to nominate someone to receive a harvest gift. This could be an elderly relative or neighbour. Please do check with them that they would be happy to receive a harvest gift first. Please send a note into school with the person's details if you would like to nominate someone. The gift will be a selection of goods and can be delivered personally by yourself to your nominated person. Any gifts remaining will be distributed to the Salvation Army and Batley Food Bank.

Parents are invited to attend the harvest services but there is limited space available. Pre-school children are welcome but will need to be able to watch quietly and not disrupt the service. If they do become upset please do take them out as it can become very difficult for other children and parents to hear the service.

If you are attending either service you may take your child straight home after collecting them from their class teacher, outside the church. No child will be allowed to go home with anyone other than a parent unless we have prior notification. The children not collected by parents will be walked back to school to go home at the normal time.

If your child brings a packed lunch to school and you intend to pick them up from church, please send it in a carrier bag so it can be disposed of. The children will not be taking their lunch boxes or book bags to church.

Please ensure that your child has a **waterproof coat in school on the days of their visits** as they will be walking to and from church.
