Details of the autumn term clubs will be **emailed out tomorrow**. Places will be available to book and pay for on ParentPay from Tuesday 17th July at 6pm. **Please remember to book clubs for the year group that your child will move into.**

We are excited to launch 2 new clubs this term; Tag Rugby on Mondays with Legacy Sport and Musical Theatre on Wednesdays with Strive. Our KS2 Fit for Life Club on Thursdays will continue to be subsidised. The charge will only be 50p per child for the whole of the autumn term.

In order to provide these opportunities for all, **children whose families are in receipt of certain income related benefits will be able to attend 2 clubs per week free of charge**. Please speak to the office staff for more details.

Y5/6 Personal and Social Education Work:

Mr Shapeshifter Performance - Tuesday 17th July - ParentMail

As part of their work in Personal and Social Education, the children in Years 5 and 6 will be watching a performance of Mr Shapeshifter in school. This is an exciting, contemporary fairy-tale designed to teach the children about personal safety, the ways in which some adults abuse the trust that children put in them and how they can protect themselves. It is told sensitively, in language which the children will understand. Work on this subject will take place in class prior to the performance and further discussion will follow. The performance links in with the SPICED and Sex and Relationships Education lessons that have been taught during the summer term.

Y5 & 6 Leaver's Concert - 'Robin and the Sherwood Hoodies' - Thursday 19th July

There will be two performances of the Year 5 & 6 concert on Thursday 19th July at 2pm and 6.30pm. Tickets are limited to 2 per family and are only available to parents of children in Year 5 & 6. If you would like to request tickets for the concert, please complete the request form sent home with your child earlier this week. The evening tickets do tend to be the most popular and we would advise you to return your request as soon as possible.

For the evening performance the children need to arrive in school at **6.15pm via the Y5/6 classroom doors.** Parents will need to enter school through the main entrance. The concert is expected to finish at approximately **7.30pm**. If you are not staying to watch the performance please collect your child from the Y5/6 classroom doors.

Please do not use mobile phones or other devices to take photographs of the children while they are performing in school.

The children will need their **costumes in school for the Dress Rehearsal** during the morning of **Wednesday 18th July**. The children in **Y5** will need to wear **black or grey trousers or leggings and a plain, brightly coloured top.** Please send these items into school as soon as possible in a named carrier bag. This will then stay on their peg until it is needed. Staff have already discussed costumes with the children in Y6.

Photographs of the cast will be on display in the school hall from Wednesday 18th July and will be available to order at £1 per copy. The last day for orders will be Friday 20th July.

We will be recording the dress rehearsal performance of the concert. If you would like to order a download code for the video there will be a charge of £3. Please send your payment in cash to the office in a named envelope marked 'Y5/6 Concert Download' by Wednesday 19th July. The codes will be issued by email after Thursday 20th July.

School Council Theme Day – Monday 23rd July – Non-uniform

As part of our work on the British Value of Democracy, Mrs Goodall and the School Councillors organised an Election in school on Thursday 5th July. Prior to the election each class had voted for a theme that they would like for a non-uniform day. On the day each child visited the polling booth with their voting card and voted for their favourite theme. The results were announced in Collective Worship on Monday afternoon.

In **KS1** (Reception, Y1/2) the children voted for a **Circus theme** and in **KS2** (Y3-6) they voted for a **Hollywood theme**. On Monday 23rd July we would like the children to come to school dressed in their own clothes, based on these themes. They will take part in a range of themed activities during the morning.

'Guide Dogs' Non-uniform Day £1 - Tuesday 24th July

The last day of term will be a non-uniform day in support of the Guide Dogs charity. The children may wear their own clothes for a donation of £1. Brittany Stead, a former pupil who uses a Guide Dog, has arranged for the charity's Puppy Room and Mobile Sensory Unit to visit us during the day. She will be talking to the children about the work that the charity does during Collective Worship on Monday.

The children may also bring toys into school on the last day of term day but please do not send anything that is particularly special or valuable e.g. DS, mobile phones etc.

Uniform Reminders

As this is the time of year when new uniform is being purchased, here is a reminder of our uniform requirements.

- grey or black short trousers/shorts, trousers, skirts, pinafores or culottes
- plain style blue and white checked/striped school dresses
- plain white (no longer yellow) polo shirt/blouse or plain white school type shirt/blouse
- school sweatshirt, sweatshirt cardigan or plain navy/royal blue cardigan, jumper or sweatshirt

No cycling, 'beach type' or jersey shorts and no denim or tracksuit bottoms please. Grey/white jumpers/sweatshirts/cardigans are not acceptable.

PE/Games kit

- Shorts and T-shirt or leotard (plain colours only).
- School PE t-shirts and shorts.
- Pumps or shoe type trainers.

No logo other than the school logo should be worn.

Shoes

The children are expected to wear **sensible** black shoes. In the summer plain black, navy or white sandals are permitted. **Black** trainers may be worn, shoe type only. All shoes should be suitable for the children to wear in class and whilst playing out at playtime and lunchtime. High heeled shoes or boots, sling backed, flimsy or 'beach type' footwear is not suitable for school wear and is not permitted.

Bags

As there is only a limited amount of room in the cloakrooms PE/Games kit should be kept in a pump bag. Large rucksacks are not suitable and should not be used. Reading Books should be kept in a Book Bag.

Please mark all your children's clothes clearly with his/her name. 'Sewn in' nametapes are recommended.

Dinner Money – Autumn Term

The price of a school meal will be £2.20 per day, £11 per full week from September 2018. Please note that if your child is changing from sandwiches to school lunches you are required to complete a school meal changes form indicating any allergies your child may have. There is a 2 week notice period to change your child's lunch arrangements. Thank you.

Reception & KS1 (Y1 & 2)

As you are aware, a Universal Infant Free School Meal is available for children in Reception, Year 1 & Year 2 only. If your child is currently in Year 2 and will continue to have school meals in September you will be required to pay for their meal at a cost of £2.20 per day.

KS2 (Y3, 4, 5 & 6)

Please pay through ParentPay. Please note that payments should be in advance and not in arrears. A considerable amount of time is taken chasing outstanding debts. You can set up a low balance alert in ParentPay as a reminder to top up your payments. Thank you.

Wednesday and Friday Lunch Club

Next term we are continuing to offer **Wednesday and Friday lunch club**. If you would like to book either or both lunch clubs you will need to pay via ParentPay by the **Friday of the previous week**. Bookings for the first week back in September need to be made by **Friday 20**th **July**. Please pay by ParentPay, using the notes box to indicate the days you are booking for.
