Language & Literacy: This half term we will be learning about:

- Reading and writing poetry
- Letter writing
- Understanding genre types
- We will also have discrete SPaG lessons once a week

We will be focussing heavily on presentation, spelling and punctuation this term. It is expected that all the children will join up their handwriting. The spellings for this half term are on the back of the curriculum outline.

Numeracy:

- Decimal place value
- fractions – simplifying, equivalent and addition/subtraction, multiplication and division
- decimals
- Fraction, decimal and percentage equivalents

There will be a focus on multiplication tables, problem solving and reasoning. Children will be encouraged to use TT Rockstars at home in order to ensure speed of recall. We will also be looking at the division tables and becoming fluent in using the maths we know to help solve tricky problems. We will be looking at the most effective and the most efficient methods.

Science: This half term we will be learning about:

- Our science topic this half term looks at separating materials using such techniques as filtering and sieving. We will look at reversible and irreversible changes

Computing: This half term we will be learning about:

- Coding – Writing algorithm to create a multi level game.
- Using computing skills to present work in interesting ways.
