English

Class Book:

This half term the children will be reading the Egyptian Cinderella.

They will be writing a non-chronological report and a narrative.

We will focus on handwriting and accurate use of key punctuation.

We will look at sentence structure and extending our ideas and vocabulary.

We will be extending our ideas by the use of adverbials, conjunctions. We will use paragraphs more effectively.

We will focus on reading fluency, pace and comprehension.

Maths

This half term the children will be studying:

Multiplication and division – consolidating our understanding of these concepts, looking at how to use the inverse to help our calculating.

We will be learning about length and perimeter

We will continue to focus on our multiplication tables and developing our reasoning skills in maths. We will consolidate our previous learning by use of Flash Back 4, a daily fluency resource.
